




A RESOLUTION FOR THE PURPOSE OF INCREASING THE COUNTY SALES TAX ONE PERCENT FOR THE PURPOSE OF PROPERTY TAX RELIEF, PURSUANT TO K.S.A. 19-117.



BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners, Woodson County, Kansas:


1. The Board of County Commissioners of Woodson County, Kansas deems it to be in the public interest to increase the county sales tax one percent as provided for by K.S.A. 19-117, for the purpose of property tax relief on the county.
2. Said tax increase shall become effective on the 61st day following the publication of the Resolution, unless a protest Petition, signed by not less than five (5%) percent of the registered voters of Woodson County, Kansas if filed with the Woodson County Clerk, within sixty (60) days following the final publication of this Resolution.
3. This resolution shall be published once each week for two (2) consecutive weeks in the official county newspaper.

IT IS RESOLVED THIS 5th DAY OF October, 2004, at the regular meeting of the Board of County Commissioners, Woodson County Courthouse, Woodson County, Kansas.
