A RESOLUTION PERMITTING SALE OF ALCOHOLIC LIQUOR BY THE INDIVIDUAL DRINK IN WOODSON COUNTY, KANSAS TO BE A SPECIAL QUESTION ON THE NOVEMBER BALLOT


WHEREAS, Woodson County does not permit sale of liquor by individual drink, and


WHEREAS, pursuant to Kansas Statutes Annotated, Section 41-2646 the issue of liquor by the drink may be placed upon the ballot by resolution of the county commission.


IT IS THEREFORE, by the Woodson County Commission resolved that the following question be placed on the ballot in the next general election, to-wit:

“Shall sale of alcoholic liquor by the individual drink in Woodson county be allowed in public places without a requirement that any portion of the gross receipts be from sales of food.”


