RESOLUTION NO. 98-07

A RESOLUTION TO SUBMIT TO THE QUALIFIED ELECTORS OF WOODSON COUNTY, KANSAS, THE PROPOSITION OF LEVYING A ONE PERCENT (1.0%) RETAILER'S SALES TAX IN WOODSON COUNTY, KANSAS

WHEREAS, K.S.A. 12-187 et. seq., as amended, authorizes the board of county commissioners of any county to submit to the qualified voters of the county the question of levying a retailer's sales tax, such tax to be collected by the State Department of Revenue with the revenue there from returned to this county; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Woodson County, Kansas has received a petition signed by electors of Woodson County equal in number to not less than ten percent (10%) of the electors of Woodson County who voted at the last preceding general election for the office of Secretary of State, requesting that the question be submitted to the electors of Woodson County, Kansas regarding a one percent (1.0%) retailer's sales tax.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of Woodson County, Kansas,

Section One -- A special question election shall be held in the manner prescribed by law on the and day of November, 1998, for the purpose of submitting to the qualified voters of Woodson County, Kansas, the question of levying a retailer's sales tax

in Woodson County, Kansas in the amount of one percent (1.0%), such tax to take effect on February 1, 1999, if approved by a majority of the electors voting thereon.

Section Two -- If approved by a majority of the electors voting thereon, such tax shall be subject to all applicable state laws and administrative rules and regulations of the Kansas Department of Revenue. The services of the Department of Revenue shall be utilized to administer, enforce and collect such tax.

<u>Section Three</u> -- The county clerk and county election officers shall cause notices to be published of this special question election, as provided by law.
