## RESOLUTION NO. 21-10

A RESOLUTION CONCERNING APPROVAL OF A CONDITIONAL USE PERMIT ON CERTAIN PROPERTY IN THE UNINCORPORATED PORTION OF WOODSON COUNTY, KANSAS.

WHEREAS, an application was made for a Conditional Use Permit by Still Waters Edge Retreat, LLC and Todd and Melissa Stiffler for the operation of a campground and event location on the tract of land located at 1245 Kanza Road, Yates Center, KS; and,

WHEREAS, the Woodson County Joint Planning Commission has conducted a public hearing on said application for a Conditional Use Permit for a campground and event location on said land on April 28, 2021 and continued to May 3, 2021; and,

WHEREAS, the Woodson County Joint Planning Commission has recommended the Conditional Use Permit for a campground and event location on said land be approved, subject to certain conditions;

## NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF WOODSON COUNTY, KANSAS, that:

- 1. The recommendation of the Woodson County Joint Planning Commission for a Conditional Use Permit on the above described land is hereby approved, subject to the following conditions:
  - a.) Still Waters Edge Retreat's General Rules be upheld which are as follows:
    - No parking on the grass.
    - Minimum stay for a recognized holidays is (3) nights. Stays during a recognized Holiday can only be cancelled as a whole, not in parts. Recognized Holidays are: Memorial Day, Labor Day and Independence Day when it falls on a weekend.
    - One camper per site. Campfires allowed in the fire rings ONLY. No campfires after midnight. All fires must be extinguished before leaving the premises.
    - The consumption of alcohol will be allowed in campsites only. Alcohol consumption will be limited to individuals 21 years of age or older.
    - Obey campground traffic regulations and observe one-way traffic patterns.
    - Keep the campground clean by placing all refuse in the trash containers. Do NOT put trash in campfires.
    - We are VERY pet friendly and do not restrict breeds. However, pets must be kept on a leash no longer than 6 feet. Clean up after your pet.
    - No fireworks, firearms or amplified sound.
    - Please observe quiet hours of 10 pm to 7 am.
    - No washing of camping RV, towed trailer or towing vehicle.
    - Please do not leave trash at your site. Utilize the dumpster throughout the duration and at the end of your stay.
    - Be courteous to other campers and have fun!;
  - b.) A row of trees planted between cabins/RV sites and south property line to create a privacy screen;
  - c.) No more RV sites without new conditional use permit application;
  - d.) No more cabins without new conditional use permit application;

- e.) No General Store without new conditional use permit application;
- f.) A camp host must be on-site when campground or event location is occupied;
- 2. This Resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after it publication once in the official county newspaper.
