

A RESOLUTION CONCERNING THE SALARY AND COMPENSATION OF EMPLOYEES AND OFFICERS OF WOODSON COUNTY.

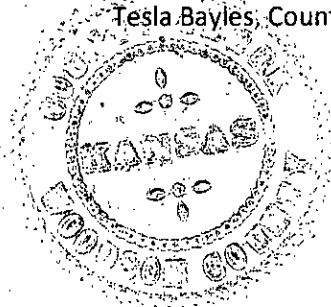
BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF WOODSON COUNTY, KANSAS that by a majority vote of the Board of County Commissioners sitting in regular session on the 11th day of January 2022 adopt the following provision concerning compensation and salary of employees and officers of Woodson County, Kansas, to-wit:

1. Any Department Head wishing to waive their cost of living adjustment and distribute it to an employee(s) within their department may do so at their discretion.
2. That all salaried full-time employees and elected officials except those employees in the following departments: County Commissioners, Sheriff's Office, Appraiser and Fire Chief not on probation shall receive a salary cost of living adjustment increase of \$40.00/per check to be effective January 1st, 2022. County Commissioners, and Sheriff's Office not on probation shall receive a salary cost of living adjustment increase of \$80.00/per check to be effective January 1st, 2022. Appraiser and Fire Chief not on probation shall receive a salary cost of living adjustment increase of \$20.00/per check to be effective January 1st, 2022. Salaries to be based on the 2022 Salaried Wage Increase Approval sheet signed January 11th, 2022.
3. That all full-time hourly employees not on probation shall receive a salary cost of living adjustment increase of \$0.50 per hour and regular part-time hourly employees not on probation shall receive a salary cost of living adjustment increase \$0.25 per hour effective January 1st, 2022.
4. This resolution shall take effect upon publication one (1) time in the Yates Center News.




