

Woodson County Coronavirus Relief Fund (CRF) Task Force

Minutes September 14, 2020 Meeting

Meeting called to order at 1:00 pm with members Russell Stukey, Dr. Pegram, Jade Bucy, Becky Boice, Michelle Zimmerman and Jamie Nitsch present.

Russell stated that the radio tower did not pass inspection. It is too tall and has damage.

We reviewed the small business grant agreements.

Revenue loss was turned in by some small businesses but not all. Michelle will contact them for more information.

Direct Aid for small businesses will range from \$2,000 - \$10,000.

Discussion was held on making changes for the small business agreements.

Grant agreements for daycares discussed. Existing daycares are eligible and new daycares that are up and running by December 1, 2020. Separate plans for Direct Aid, based on the number of children.

Masks and hand sanitizer were purchased for Friends for Life. Woodson County Road & Bridge built hand sanitizer stations that can be used during Friends for Life events and the Fall Festival. A fogger was discussed to be used at these events also. Woodson County may purchase the fogger to be used at multiple events.

Applications for small businesses were looked at and amounts decided. A total of \$136,000.00 has been budgeted so far.

Michelle will meet with county commissioners tomorrow about cutting checks. All checks will be cut at once and receipts will need to be turned in by December 15, 2020 for items purchased.

The next report is due October 7, 2020.
