Forsyth made the motion to enter into a non-elected executive session for confidentially reasons with the Board and County Attorney for 10 minutes at 8:37 a.m.


The Board came back into session with all members present at 8:44 a.m. No action was taken.

The meeting adjourned at 10:00 a.m.


