

The Board of Woodson County Commissioners met in a regular business session on May 15, 2018 at 8:30 a.m. with Chairman Yoho, Vice Chairman Forsyth, Member Weseloh, County Attorney Schlotterbeck and County Clerk Denice Julian.

The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

The Agenda was unanimously approved as amended.

The Minutes of the previous meeting was approved as printed.

Weseloh made the motion that when notified of parties solicitating (peddling) products in the county to contact the County Sheriff before selling products, Forsyth seconded the motion with Yoho making it unanimous.

Road and Bridge Supervisor Dane Onnen met with the Board to let the Board know that Westar has started moving poles to the fence lines.

Onnen also reported that Dust Control will start in the middle of June.

Forsyth made the motion to all allow Onnen to hire Ryan Moffett as temporary summer help. Weseloh seconded the motion with Yoho making it unanimous.




Onnen informed the Board that he will need to replace the load rating on 3 Bridges in the County.




