

The Board of Woodson County Commissioners met in a regular business session on May 22, 2018 at 8:30 a.m. with Chairman Yoho, Vice Chairman Forsyth, Member Weseloh, County Attorney Schlotterbeck and County Clerk Denice Julian.

The Pledge of Allegiance was recited by Yoho, Forsyth, Weseloh and Julian.

The Agenda was unanimously approved as amended.

The Minutes of the previous meeting was approved as printed.

Weseloh made the motion to enter an executive session for Attorney Client Privileges to discuss legal matters with the Board and County Attorney at 8:35 a.m. for 15 minutes. Forsyth seconded the motion with Yoho making it unanimous.

The Board came back into session at 8:50 a.m. with all members present. No action was taken.

Weseloh made the motion to enter into an executive session for non-elected personnel to protect employee confidentially with the Board, County Attorney, Road and Bridge Supervisor Dane Onnen and the County Clerk for 10 minutes at 8:50 a.m. Yoho seconded the motion with Forsyth making it unanimous.

The Board came back into session at 9:00 a.m. with all members present. No action was taken.

Road and Bridge Supervisor Dane Onnen met with the Board to discuss road matters.

Forsyth made the motion to allow Onnen to hire Maggie Jennings as a full-time office clerk for the Road and Bridge department. Weseloh seconded the motion with Yoho making it unanimous.

Discussion was held on the work being done at Fegan Lake.

Yoho informed the Board that someone had ran into an air conditioner unit at Heritage Hills Apartment. There was a police report taken.

Laura Sterling American Legion Auxiliary Unit 13 President presented the Board a poppy since May 25th is National Poppy Day.

Treasurer Michelle Zimmerman presented the Board April monthly reports for the Board to review. Forsyth made the motion to sign the monthly reports. Weseloh seconded the motion with Yoho making it unanimous.

Onnen reported that he had talked to Mike Fitzgerald about road conditions in the Neosho Falls area. Fitzgerald was on the agenda to talk to the Commissioners. Onnen stated that Fitzgerald would not be at the meeting today.


Weseloh reported on the ALICE training at the Courthouse.


Forsyth made the motion to approve claim vouchers and county warrants in the amount of \$114,314.51. Weseloh seconded the motion with Yoho making it unanimous.


The meeting adjourned at 11:15 a.m.
