

RESOLUTION NO. 96-02

A RESOLUTION CONCERNING COMPENSATION OF COUNTY  
EMPLOYEE'S AND OFFICERS UPON TERMINATION OF THEIR EMPLOYMENT

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF WOODSON COUNTY, KANSAS, THAT BY A MAJORITY VOTE OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS SITTING IN REGULAR SESSION ON THE 30<sup>th</sup> DAY OF January, 1996, ADOPT THE FOLLOWING PROVISIONS CONCERNING COMPENSATION UPON TERMINATION OF EMPLOYMENT OF ALL COUNTY EMPLOYEE'S AND OFFICERS, to-wit:

1. That upon the termination of employment of any county officer or employee who has accrued vacation time but not taken it as of the date of his or her termination of employment, then such employee or officer shall be entitled to payment for such unused vacation time.

2. That upon the termination of employment of any county employee or officer who has accrued unused sick leave in excess of 480 hours shall be entitled to compensation of such unused sick leave in excess of 480 hours up to 560 hours of accrued sick leave.

This Resolution shall take effect upon publication one time in the Yates Center News.
