RESOLUTION NUMBER 96-09

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE SOUTHEAST KANSAS SOLID WASTE OPERATING AUTHORITY (SEKSWOA) TO APPLY TO THE KANSAS DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND ENVIRONMENT (KDH&E) FOR GRANT FUNDING UNDER THE SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT WASTE TIRE BASE GRANT PROGRAM ON BEHALF OF WOODSON COUNTY, AND UPON AWARD OF SUCH GRANT FUNDING, AUTHORIZING SEKSWOA TO ADMINISTER SUCH FUNDS ON BEHALF OF WOODSON COUNTY AND THE RESPECTIVE SEKSWOA MEMBER COUNTIES IN A MANNER CONSISTENT WITH THEIR INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT.

WHEREAS, WOODSON County has entered into an interlocal agreement with seven Southeast Kansas counties to form the SEKSWOA in accordance with K.S.A. 12-2901; and

WHEREAS, The SEKSWOA Board of Directors and the WOODSON County Commission desire to implement solid waste management strategies delineated in the solid waste management plans of the respective SEKSWOA member counties and applicable to SEKSWOA as approved by KDH&E; and

WHEREAS, The abatement of waste tire piles is necessary to the healthful and the sanitary living conditions of WOODSON County; and

WHEREAS, The location and enumeration of waste tire piles is a foundational component of a successful waste tire abatement strategy; and

WHEREAS, SEKSWOA desires to apply to the KDH&E Solid Waste Management Waste Tire Base Grant Program for funding necessary to implement strategies for locating and enumerating waste tire piles within WOODSON County and the respective SEKSWOA member counties; and


WHEREAS, KDH&E rules will allow SEKSWOA to apply on behalf of WOODSON County for Solid Waste Management Waste Tire Base Grant Program funds not to exceed \$5,000 for the purpose of locating and enumerating waste tire piles with no matching fund requirement; and

WHEREAS, SEKSWOA desires to apply to the KDH&E Solid Waste Management Waste Tire Base Grant Program for funding on behalf of all eight respective member counties in an amount not to exceed \$5,000.00 per county, or \$40,000.00 total; and

WHEREAS, The citizens of WOODSON County may benefit from cooperative administration, accounting, and purchase of services by applying for and utilizing said grant funds through the cooperative efforts of SEKSWOA.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT: Consistent with the provisions of the SEKSWOA Interlocal Cooperative Agreement between Allen, Bourbon, Cherokee, Crawford, Labette, Neosho, Wilson, and Woodson Counties, the Governing Body of WOODSON County, Kansas hereby requests that the Southeast Kansas Solid Waste Operating Authority apply for and, upon award, administer KDH&E Solid Waste Management Waste Tire Base Grant funding on its behalf.
