
A RESOLUTION ATTESTING TO THE POSSIBLE INCREASE IN TAXES LEVIED FOR BUDGET YEAR 2000 NECESSARY TO FINANCE PUBLIC SERVICES FOR THE COUNTY OF WOODSON.


Be it resolved by the Woodson County Board of Commissioners:

Section One. In accordance with the state law, the County of Woodson has conducted a public hearing and has published the proposed budget necessary to fund County services from January 1, 2000 until December 31, 2000.

Section Two. After careful public deliberations, it is hereby attested that in order to maintain the public services, which are essential for the citizens of this county, it will be necessary to utilize property tax revenues in an amount which exceeds the revenues expended in the budget year 1999.
